- the Knight Trainer sale did get some bites but no solid sale as of yet - will follow up

CONCERNS/NEXT STEPS

- validity of hosting our annual North Central Tournament in April 2021
- too early to tell when return to play returns to where we were at a year ago

SECRETARY, Karenza Chui

- Drew up agenda for AGM, attend AGM, draft the minutes afterwards and distribute to executive for review
- Submitted Annual Report to BC Registries after the AGM and pay the filing fee. This is a straightforward online form confirming the organisation's registered address and directors. If changes occur during the year, these should also be filed with BC Registries, but this is unusual for us

DIRECTOR AT LARGE, Lisa Davison

Event Hosting

2020 North Central Tournament

- did not host due to the hosting of a National event – not enough human resources to do both
- did not matter even if we had tried to host our regional event, the pandemic hit in March 2020 and cancelled everything

2020 Canadian Masters Badminton Championship (CMBC)

- planning, volunteers, organization, sponsors, and funding all going well and we were within budget as of March 2020
- Mar 12th it became clear that the reality of hosting this event was uncertain
- in consultation with Badminton Canada on March 28th it was decided to postpone until 2021 and Calgary would change their host year to 2022
- come mid-May the 2020 CMBC Committee met to discuss even hosting in 2021 - sponsors wanted their 2020 sponsorship back and there was no guarantees we would get the funds back; will the venue even be available? the age of our participants is a concern; so many unknowns to keep a committee motivated
- the 2020 CMBC Committee also consulted with Badminton Canada - even with their suggestions of reducing technical officials to just a Referee and eliminating one or two social events the financial risks were high let alone the pandemic issues
- May 22nd, 2020 the announcement was made public that the 2021 CMBC in Prince George was cancelled

CONCERNS/NEXT STEPS

- will a 2021 North Central Tournament happen or not?
- the financials for the 2020 CMBC will have to be wrapped up, bank account closed, reports filed, return any sponsorship money and grant money, return of any goods, pay any bills, flight cancellations and so on
